- Article 6. To elect one (1) school director for a term of three (3) years.
- Article 7. Shall the voters of the Wells Town School District appropriate \$2,412,817.15 for the support of its school for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2015 and ending June 30, 2016?

- * 8. Shall the Town vote to appropriate \$8,000.00 to the Granville Rescue Squad for their services to the Town of Wells?
- * 9. Shall the Town vote to appropriate \$2,303.00 to the Rutland Area VNA & Hospice?
- * 10. Shall the Town vote to appropriate \$2,000.00 to Our Neighbors Table?
- * 11. Shall the town vote to appropriate \$1,030.00 to the Rutland Mental Health Services, Inc.?
- * 12. Shall the Town vote to appropriate \$1,000.00 to the Southwestern Vermont Council on Aging?
- * 13. Shall the Town vote to appropriate \$600.00 to the Rutland County Parent Child Center?
- * 14. Shall the Town vote to appropriate \$500.00 to the Vermont Association for the Blind and Visually Impaired?

- * 19. Shall the Town vote to appropriate \$200.00 to Neighbor Works of Western Vermont?
- * 20. Shall the Town vote to appropriate \$160.00 to the Vermont Center for Independent Living?
- * 21. Shall the Town vote to appropriate \$150.00 to the Rutland County Humane Society?
- * 22. Shall the Town vote to appropriate \$150.00 to the Rutland County Women's Network & Shelter, Inc.?
- * 23. Shall the Town vote to appropriate \$100.00 to Green Up Vermont?
- * 24. Shall the Town vote to appropriate \$100.00 to Vermont Rural Fire Protection Task Force?
- * 25. Shall the Town of Wells vote to add two (2) additional members to the Select Board, each with a two (2) year term; but staggered so that the year the additional selectmen are first elected, one shall be elected for a one (1) year term and the other for a two (2) year term, both terms ending on the annual meeting day and every term thereafter to be a two (2) year term?
