

WELLS TOWN SCHOOL DISTRICT WARNING
Annual School District Meeting
February 29, 2016 and March 1, 2016

The legal voters of the Wells Town School District are hereby notified and warned to meet at the Multi-purpose room of the Wells Village School Building in said Town on Monday, February 29, 2016 at seven o'clock in the evening to transact the following business from the floor:

February 29, 2016

- Article 1. To hear the reports of the School Board and other District officials and act thereon.
- Article 2. To hold a public informational meeting to discuss articles to be voted on by Australian ballot on March 1, 2016.
- Article 3. To transact any other lawful business to come before the meeting.

March 1, 2016

The legal voters of the Wells Town School District are hereby further warned to meet at the Wells Town Office on Tuesday, March 1, 2016 at eight o'clock in the morning at which time the polls will open and remain open until seven o'clock in the evening to vote on the following articles by Australian ballot:

- Article 4. To elect a moderator for a term of one (1) year.
- Article 5. To elect a school district clerk for a term of one (1) year.
- Article 6. To elect one (1) school director for a term of three (3) years.
- Article 7. Shall the voters of the Wells Town School District approve the school board to expend \$2,326,184.74, which is the amount the school board has determined to be necessary for the ensuing fiscal year? It is estimated that this proposed budget, if approved, will result in education spending of \$12,625 per equalized pupil. This projected spending per equalized pupil is 6.7% lower than spending for the current year.
- It is estimated that this proposed budget and the following article(s), if approved, will result in total education spending of \$12,691 per equalized pupil. This projected total spending per equalized pupil is 6.2% lower than spending for the current year.
- Article 8. Shall the voters of the Wells Town School District approve the school board to transfer \$5,000.00 of the FY15 surplus into the Maintenance Fund?
- Article 9. Shall the voters of the Wells Town School District approve the school board to transfer \$5,000.00 of the FY15 surplus into the Building Renovation Fund?
