

WELLS SPRINGS UNIFIED UNION SCHOOL DISTRICT WARNING

Annual School District Meeting

February 28 and March 6, 2018

The legal voters of the Wells Springs Unified Union School District consisting of the towns of Middleton Springs and Wells, are hereby notified and warned to meet at the Wells Village School in said Town at seven o'clock in the evening on Wednesday February 28, 2018, to transact any of the following business (Articles 1 – 6) not involving voting by Australian ballot. Upon the conclusion of the business not involving Australian ballot, the meeting is to be adjourned and reconvened in the respective polling places hereinafter named on Tuesday, March 6, 2018 at 7:00 A.M. (in Middleton Springs) and at 8:00 A.M. (in Wells) at which time the polls open until 7:00 P.M. at which time the polls will close, to transact any business involving voting by Australian ballot (Articles 7-8).

February 28, 2018

- Article 1. To elect a moderator for a term of one (1) year.
- Article 2. To hear the reports of the School Board and other District officials and act thereon.
- Article 3. To elect a treasurer for a term of one (1) year.
- Article 4. To elect a clerk for a term of one (1) year.
- Article 5. To hear a presentation from the School Board on the proposed 2018-19 Budget.
- Article 6. To transact any other lawful business that comes before the meeting.

March 6, 2018

- Article 7. To elect one school director who resides in the Town of Middletown Springs for a term of three (3) years.
To elect one school director who resides in the Town of Wells for a term of three (3) years.
To elect one at-large representative who resides in either the Town of Middletown Springs or Wells for a term of three (3) years.
- Article 8. School Budget: Shall the voters of the Wells Springs Unified Union School District approve the school board to expend \$4,608,440.97 which is the amount the school board has determined to be necessary for the ensuing fiscal year? It is estimated that this proposed budget, if approved, will result in education spending of \$15,253.31 per equalized pupil.

Said persons and voters are warned and notified that voter qualifications, registration, absentee voting, and voter procedures shall be in accordance with Chapters 43 and 51 of Title 17 Vermont Statutes Annotated.


Article 5 constitutes a Public Hearing.


