

The Delaney Planning Committee
Minutes of Meeting
June 14, 2021

Meeting Called to order at 7:00PM.

Cathy motions to approve the May minutes, Fran seconds, all approve.

No change in the treasurer's report.

Fran reports that Jared is still interested in the pavilion bid, and has suggested \$18,000 in labor, and \$26,395.68 in materials (with a requested \$500 cushion). Hopefully construction can start at the end of June or July. Cathy motions to approve this quote as the committee, though the final decision is of course up to the select board. Grace seconds and all agree.

It was confirmed that we want to clarify that the ceiling and gable end are made with edge and center/bead board. We should decide on the color of the roofing shingles – maybe black ones last longer?

Tim suggests checking with Hilary about the swale construction before the town crew clears out the excavated dirt.

Bill Alexander and Chris Smid made the following points:

- 1) Builder started project June 1 and estimates completing early July
- 2) Kiosk- funding was not secured for Kiosk in the order of about \$2000-2500
- 3) Horses- The committee & selectmen were in agreement with SVT that horses should not be allowed on the SVT built trails. They weren't designed to handle horse travel and are not safe for horses. SVT was instructed to use "Human Power Only" signage as needed.
- 4) Fran Gilman (selectman) and Bill walked much of the Grey Trail project being built.
- 5) Chris introduced himself and thanked Wells for their continued support and the social and economic benefits SVT sees for our communities.

LSCCF and LCA want to meet at the park to discuss the plans for milfoil control this summer. Grace motions to approve, Cathy seconds, everyone agrees.

There is a discussion of how to deal with future events at the park, do people need to reserve the space for a large gathering? Should there be a deposit for cleaning/trash removal? Further consideration is called for.

Don says the town website is being updated, if we want to change/add anything we should let the Select Board know.

Tim suggests considering getting a septic permit – we should think about it now in case we want one in the future.

Cathy brings up the idea of giving SVT some money to help with signage, since they've done so much for the park (and byway, the town). Everyone agrees but thinks we should wait till we've paid for the pavilion and see what funds we have left.
