Damage or loss of roads, bridges, public utilities (e.g., water, sewer)
Business closure or loss
Damage to schools and other public properties (e.g., parks, buildings)
Loss or damage to agricultural operations
Damage to environmental resources (e.g., wetlands, lakes, ponds, rivers, forests)
Damage or loss of cultural/historic properties
– Loss of Wildlife
